Read John 3:1-15

Icebreaker: Have you ever made a promise to somebody? How did you go following it through?

- Who was Nicodemus?
- Why did Nicodemus come at night do you think?
- Why do you think this passage doesn't exist in other gospels?
- What are the reasons that Nicodemus believed Jesus was from God?

General

Deeper

- What does it mean to be born again? How would you be changed according to Jesus?
- Jesus explains that there is water and spirit must be involved. See Ezekiel 36:25-27 and explain to each other what this means.
- Nicodemus may have come to Jesus with a pre-existing yet incomplete understanding of the scriptures, what do you think Nicodemus's idea of the Kingdom of God was like?
- Explain v14. Exactly how is the Son of Man like a snake in the wilderness?

Mission

- Nicodemus is amazed that, despite being very high status and devoted with his works, it is not enough to get into Heaven. How can this be a message of hope?

Jesus is the Sacrifice (ANZAC Day)



Read Romans 5:6-8, John 15: 7-17

Greater Love has no one than this, that he lay down his life for his friends
- John 15:13

There are many stories, from across the centuries, of godly people who sacrificed their comfort and safety—and, yes, even their lives—to share the message of Christ's sacrifice for us. God's intention has always been to be in relationship with humankind, but since the fall (Genesis 2) we have sinned and turned away from God. We read verses such as John 3:16–17 reminding us that God provided a way for us to be in relationship with Him again, but this came at a price. The sacrifice Jesus paid through His death and the victory he won in resurrection means that sin is conquered and salvation is secured for everyone who believes in Him.

Read John 3:16-21

Icebreaker: Have you ever tried walking in the dark. Maybe to get to the bathroom one night or a midnight snack. Have you ever hurt yourself in the process?

General

- Read the passage and make any interesting observations. Have you ever loved something or someone so much, you've made great sacrifices?
- Why do you think God loves humans? Even though we are imperfect?
- Where does Jesus go after his meeting with Nicodemus?

Deeper

- What is the issue with mankind according to Jesus? And what is the solution?
- How does v16 involve gentiles? What does this say about the love for mankind. Finally, how was this received by the Jewish leaders and early Christians?
- What does it take to 'believe'? Does just 'believing' in the name of Jesus really save you from eternal condemnation?
- Discuss why anyone would want to reject the offer of life.

Mission

- Have you had an opportunity to share the love of Jesus this week to a non-believer?
- Have you also had an opportunity to share the love of Jesus to a fellow brother or sister in Christ?
